

Red Rose Lodge #16 Fraternal Order of Police Scholarship Procedures and Application Form

Article 1. Scholarship Policy

The Scholarship Committee of the Red Rose Lodge #16 Fraternal Order of Police shall review all applications for the scholarship and forward the name of any qualified candidate(s), for said scholarship, to the general membership for approval by a majority vote of those present at the April regular monthly meeting. All questions should be directed to the Scholarship Committee.

This is a one-year, one-time scholarship of \$2,000 per applicant, with a maximum of two scholarship recipients each year.

The scholarship funds will be distributed to the institution of higher learning that has accepted the candidate. One-half will be distributed upon the student's admission, and the second-half will be distributed upon the student's successful completion of the first semester with a minimum of a 3.0 GPA. The first payment will be sent at the beginning of the freshman year with full semester hours, and does not cover summer school. The timing of these payments will be discussed with the student, the student's parents or legal guardian, and the institution of higher learning.

This policy may be amended by a majority vote of those present at a regular monthly Lodge meeting of the Red Rose Lodge # 16 Fraternal Order of Police.

Article 2. Eligibility

1. The applicant must be a citizen of the United States and must maintain a permanent residence in Lancaster County or any adjoining County.
2. The applicant must be a high school senior planning to attend a post-secondary institution of higher learning with a minimum of a minor concentration of study in the Law Enforcement field.
3. The applicant must have a father, mother, grandparent or legal guardian who is an active member or active retired member of the Red Rose Lodge # 16 Fraternal Order of Police. The member shall maintain a membership status in good standing throughout the entire process and award distribution period.
4. The applicant's High School Grade Point Average (GPA) must be a minimum of 3.0 or its equivalent during the last two years in High School.
5. All Eligibility requirements must be satisfied for scholarship distribution.

Article 3. Scholastic Record

The applicant must send a copy of the official high school transcript of grades for the past two years to the address listed in Article 5. The applicant shall ask the following three people to submit a recommendation to this scholarship review committee by April 7 of the award year.

1. Teacher
2. Counselor
3. Parent/Legal Guardian

Each person must include their address and phone number.

Article 4. Narrative Statement

Applicant must submit a brief summary providing:

a. Extra-curricular activities, community support activities and experiences including any leadership roles.

b. Scholastic and working career plans, goals, ideas, and interests.

c. Institution of higher learning information and Admissions Office where the applicant has been accepted.

The following paragraph must be included at the end of the narrative submitted by the Applicant:

“I hereby affirm that the information contained herein is correct, and I promise to notify the Red Rose Lodge #16 Scholar Review Committee of any changes.”
