

POLICE LODGE DROPS GARDEN SPOT OUTFIT

State Convention Acts Be-
cause Members Are
Mostly Constables

PEFFLEY AT SESSION

Allentown, Pa.—(AP)—The state convention of the Fraternal Order of Police Tuesday suspended the Garden Spot Lodge, No. 92, of Lancaster county.

The action was taken, a spokesman explained, because the order is composed primarily of municipal police officers while the Lancaster group is mostly constables.

The state body's action is final but the lodge can appeal to the grand lodge.

Reading will be host to the 1940 convention, the Berks city police being the lone bidder for the sessions.

All elective officers will have opposition Wednesday, with the exception of Ira W. Bohn, of York, who was nominated for the newly created office of chaplain. President J. Bert Haggerty of Erie, is to be opposed by Martin O'Toole of Pittsburgh.
