

## DEISLEY TO RETIRE: POLICEMAN 20 YRS.

Commissioner of Police Carlson announced today that Sergeant Fred H. Deisley, 717 E. Walnut St.,



had made an application for retirement on completion of 20 years of service on the city police department.

Deisley joined the police force on May 28, 1923, being promoted to desk sergeant in the spring of 1930. He has been contact man for Lancaster to the National Safety Council since 1934. He attended the New England Traffic Officers' Training School at Harvard University in 1936.
