

Cogley Named Grand Trustee by Police Lodge

City detective Paul R. Cogley was elected Grand Trustee of Pennsylvania at the national Fraternal Order of Police convention at Phoenix, Ariz., Saturday night. He will represent 15,400 state FOP members.

Long active in Red Rose Lodge No. 16, Cogley was named financial secretary in 1943, a year after he joined the police force. He was elected treasurer in 1951. He served as delegate to state and national conventions since 1949.
