

## Council Will Act On Traffic Bureau Post

Creation of the post of captain in the Police Traffic Bureau is scheduled for action by the City Council at its meeting in the Municipal Building this morning.

Lt. Kenneth I. Witmer, present head of the bureau, would be appointed to captain if the post is created.

Also due for consideration by the council is the promotion of Patrolman Paul D. Rose of the Detective Bureau to the rank of detective and the appointment of Ronald A. Hess of 717 E. Marion St., as patrolman.

Mayor Thomas J. Monaghan said Monday that legislation to create the post of Traffic Bureau captain is needed since it was not included in the 1959 budget. It was dropped after the retirement of the late Captain Raymond E. Charles in 1957.


Rose would be appointed to the vacancy of detective recently created by the promotion of Captain Paul R. Cogley to the head of the Detective Bureau, Cogley succeeded John P. Kirchner, who retired.
