

Teamsters OK 9-A Amendment

Officer David Dommel, recording secretary of Red Rose Lodge 16, Fraternal Order of Police, Sunday spoke to members of Teamsters Local 771 on binding arbitration for police and firemen.

During the meeting at Teamsters Hall, Local 771 approved a resolution supporting the 9-A Amendment concerning salary arbitration that will appear on Tuesday's ballot.

Dommel told teamsters binding arbitration would result if 9-A is approved by voters. Defining arbitration as "a safety valve to avert strikes", Dommel told teamsters it would be the legal way for police and firemen to "negotiate our disputes with the city."
