



Police Lodge Clears Wires

The building which will serve as the lodge of Red Rose Lodge No. 16, Fraternal Order of Police, was moved through the east side of the city Monday afternoon to the lot it will occupy at Engleside.

Low hanging trees and electrical wires in the residential area of Lehigh Avenue and Broad Street snagged the house several times.

Workmen, pictured above, were stationed on the roof of the

building to lift branches and wires as the huge cargo moved along its route.

The building was moved from the old Pensupreme property in the northeast section of the city,

south on Broad Street, then west on Chesapeake Street.

City police assisted in diverting traffic while the truck carried the building south on Queen Street, which is one-way north, to its site at Engleside.
